This well-bred and scopey gelding is just the sort to come into his own at three, before hopefully embarking on a dual-purpose career. His sire Tiger Hill was a multiple Group 1 winner on the Flat and has gone on to produce talented horses under both codes, including Rewilding and Ghizao, while Trompette was a useful winner over hurdles for the Club.



DOYLY CARTE

TRAINED BY DONALD McCAIN JR.

This athletic and rangy half-sister to the classy Dandino is by the high-class Doyen, who is making a name for himself as a National Hunt stallion, out of a winning mare by the Derby winner Generous, and has been pleasing her trainer ahead of her upcoming race-course debut.

This colt's dam's two previous runners are the Listed-winning two-year-old filly Marlinka and the three-year-old winner State Fair, and this colt should make a useful handicapper next season after impressively winning his last two starts of 2011.



KINDLY NOTE

TRAINED BY EMMA LAVELLE

This daughter of Derby winner Generous is out of a prolific National Hunt mare and has joined rising star trainer Emma Lavelle. Kindly Note has already shown promise in a bumper and over hurdles and should prosper in mares' races this winter.

TRAINED BY MARK JOHNSTON

A top-class sprinter and juvenile, Royal Applause has translated his form on the track to the covering shed, with a good record for producing two-year-olds with speed, which suggests this colt, who is out of an unraced half-sister to Soviet Song, could be an exciting prospect for 2012.



NEW FFOREST

This attractive filly is by the UK's most expensive stallion, Oasis Dream, who has been one of the leading sires of recent seasons. As the second filly out of the Club's Listed-winning juvenile Ffestiniog, she is also a half-sister to numerous winners, including the Group 3-winners Border Patrol, Boston Lodge and Eisteddfod.



NEW ROMANTIC

TRAINED BY JULIE CAMACHO

This filly is a daughter of the late, brilliant and globe-trotting Singspiel, who won top-class races in Dubai, Canada, Japan and the UK prior to becoming a stallion of the highest class, to date siring twelve Group 1 winners and equine millionaires like Dar Re Mi, Moon Ballad and Eastern Anthem. She is out of an unraced half-sister to Soviet Song.



SISTINE

TRAINED BY NICKY HENDERSON

A well-bred and scopey filly, Sistine is a three-parts sister to the dam of the top-class Ballydoyle Classic hopeful Camelot, and has already shown promise, finishing second on her final turf Flat start of the year.

Green Desert - Ffestiniog
TRAINED BY ROGER CHARLTON

Daffyd is by the top-class stallion Green Desert, whose best progeny include Oasis Dream, Cape Cross and Invincible Spirit. This half-brother to the Group winners Border Patrol, Boston Lodge and Eisteddfod made an encouraging start at Newbury in October 2011.



DANDINO

A six-time winner on the Flat, including victories in the Group 2 Jockey Club Stakes and also at Royal Ascot, Dandino has proven a smart horse over the middle-distances and hopes are high that he can continue to fly the flag in 2012.

TRAINED BY JAMES GIVEN

This is the first foal of Trompette, who was a useful winner over hurdles and also a winner on the Flat in France. The dam is a half-sister to the classy National Hunt winner Am-bobo, as well as to a Listed Flat winner, and he is by the high-class stallion Halling whose best runners include the Group 1 winners Cavalryman and Cutlass Bay.



KALITHEA

TRAINED BY ROGER CHARLTON

A son of Green Desert, the speedy Kheleyf is fast making a name for himself as a prolific sire of juvenile winners which bodes well for this filly who is a half-sister to the Club's precocious Listed-winner, Marlinka, who was also trained by Roger Charlton.



LLEWELLYN

This well-bred prospect is by the Champion miler Shamardal, who has made a tremendous start as a stallion, and out of the Listed winner Ffestiniog, he is a half-brother to three Group winners. He has been placed in maidens and should be capable of winning in 2012.



MISTER DILLON

By the high-class Sulamani, the sire of 2009 St Leger winner Mastery, this homebred is a half-brother to the classy dual-purpose winner and Group-placed Dancing Bay and was already the winner of a National Hunt Flat race by the time he recently won his first two starts over hurdles, setting himself up nicely for this season.



RIBBONS

Manduro - Sister Act
TRAINED BY JAMES FANSHAWE

Manduro's first crop of two-year-olds included the Group 1 performers Bonfire and Mandeau, auguring well for his prospects as a future star of the covering shed. He was a fabulous racehorse and the world's top-rated runner in 2007, which means this filly, out of a full-sister to the five-time Group 1 winner Soviet Song, could be very exciting indeed.



RULING PARTY

Fleetwood - My Tern
TRAINED BY ALAN KING

An athletic son of Fleetwood out of a winning National Hunt mare, he has stacks of scope and ultimately has "chaser" written all over him, but looks a serious prospect for this winter over hurdles following third placings in a National Hunt Flat race and novices' hurdle.

TRAINED BY ALAN KING

Out of the prolific hurdler Kabayil, this handsome gelding is a half-brother to the talented Dancing Bay and hopefully can emulate his achievements on the Flat and over the obstacles. His trainer describes him as a very likeable type and he should run early in the new year.

Tale Of The Cat is one of the leading sires in the U.S. and is best known as the sire of the top-class Gio Ponti, but he also has a strong record for producing two-year-old winners and hopes are high that this nicely-bred filly can follow the lead of her dam, who was twice a winner as a juvenile.
